On Saturday morning, in the Garden Grove Community Center, La Casa Garcia will serve a VIP Pancake Breakfast at \$10.50 per person, hosted by actor and "The Misfit of Magic," magician, Ed Alonzo ("Saved By The Bell," "Masters of Illusion") with proceeds benefiting We Give Thanks. Breakfast attendees will include parade celebrities, local dignitaries, the yet to be named Miss Garden Grove 2022, and Miss Strawberry Grove 2020 and her court, and Miss Strawberry Grove 2020 Monica Waldau.

At 10 a.m. on Saturday, film, television and stage celebrities, elected officials and VIPS, floats, equestrians, marching bands and the Strawberry Festival's Mascot will be featured in the Parade. Music and live entertainment will be provided in the 550-seat Amphitheater and Showmobile. Festival goers will be able to dine on a delicious and diverse lineup of food including smoothies, crepes, strawberry sundaes and strawberry shortcake, chocolate covered strawberries—and more! Food sales will help fund local charities.
