Celebrity Grand Marshal - Vera Jimenez - KTLA 5 On Air Personality



Vera Jimenez is KTLA 5's meteorologist for the KTLA 5 News at 5, 6, 6:30, 10 and 11 on weeknights.

Vera was born in Mexico and moved to Southern California when she was 3. Most of her family still lives in Garden Grove. She went to Bolsa Grande High School and Santa Ana Community College.

She later attended Cal State Long Beach where she graduated with honors in religious studies. It was during her time at SACC that she started in broadcasting. She interned at KIK-FM in Orange and then got a job producing traffic for Shadow Broadcasting. She landed a fill-in job doing traffic overnights at

KFWB-AM. The best learning experience came while at KNX-AM, where she was an airborne traffic reporter.

Vera eventually got a chance to work on television — first for KABC-TV and then for KCBS-TV, both here in Los Angeles. While at KCBS-TV, Vera went back to school to study meteorology from Mississippi State, earning her certificate in August 2009.

Vera has earned four Emmys, three Golden Mikes and three Golden Pylons.





Theme Grand Marshal - Tony Adkins, PA-C - aka The Dancing Doc



Tony "Dancing Doc" Adkins, PA-C, MPH, MCHS, is a pediatric neurosurgery physician assistant at Children's Hospital of Orange County and now a social media phenomenon. In a matter of months he became well known around the world for his unique way of connecting with his young patients through music and dance. He has appeared on Good Morning America, The Dr. Oz Show, ABC World News Tonight, Australia Morning News, and on several other national and international news and talk shows. These media outlets have affectionately named him the "Dancing Doc" because his dance videos with his patients have gone viral with millions of views.

He often states that he is well aware that there isn't one specific approach that is always the right one for every child. He uses this method with the intentions of

lifting his patient's spirits trying to remind them of happiness that can often leave them while in hospitals. Tony's training focus is in assessing and treating children with closed head injuries, brain tumors, cerebral palsy, and various other neurosurgical ailments. His educational background includes a Masters in Clinic Health Sciences with a focus on physician assistant studies from University of Washington in Seattle, Washington, a Masters in Public Health in Global Health and Epidemiology from Loma Linda University, and a B.S. in Neuroscience from University of California Riverside.

He is happily married to his lovely wife, LaVeta, and a father to his two beautiful daughters, Chloe and Zoe.





Strawberry Festival History

In 1958, the Garden Grove Chamber of Commerce organized the first Garden Grove Strawberry Festival to bring together the east and west sides of Garden Grove. Resident Tom Hoxie, a public relations professional, suggested a festival to celebrate the area's then-prolific strawberry fields. That first festival, held on a vacant lot in the Brookhurst Triangle, bordered by Garden Grove Blvd., Brookhurst St., and Brookhurst Way, was a smashing success.

The following year, when the Chamber decided not to hold a strawberry festival, a group of citizens formed the Garden Grove Strawberry Festival Association and moved the festival to Garden Grove Park where there was more parking. Years later, the festival location changed to the Village Green Park, its current location.

Many people believe that the City produces the Festival. It is actually produced and run by a group of dedicated volunteers that make up the Garden Grove Strawberry Festival Association. The festival has always been a charitable event supporting local non-profit organizations. Over the past 62 years, the Association has donated over \$7 million dollars to hundreds of non-profit organizations. Charities such as Kiwanisland, The GG Lions Club, Ronald McDonald House, homeless and abuse shelters, and children's non-profits have benefited over the years. Also, the Association awards scholarships annually to GGUSD Seniors and provides approximately 2,000 special needs children with a day dedicated to their delight. Garden Grove Service clubs are the only groups allowed to sell food and run multiple game booths at the festival. The four-day event allows each group to raise needed funds for their organizations, often enough to fund all their causes for the year. 



Ric was a well-known, beloved figure around Garden Grove. He was a devoted volunteer who was determined and committed to giving back to the community, which he called his home since 1966.





In 2017, Ric was honored by the Cypress Americana Foundation as Man of the Year. In 2021, he was selected as Garden Grove's Man of the Year, and in 2023, he received the Lions International - Melvin Jones Award.

Ric was a devoted Catholic and actively involved at his church, St. Columban, where he served an unprecedented eight years on the Parish Council, held the position of School Board President, and was a 4th Degree Knight of Columbus.

A resolute and loving man, Ric adored his wife, Susie, their children, and grandchildren; he entertained with his quick wit and humor, his ability to tell a joke and talk about any current event.
